5. Treasurer's Report

lan read out a summary of the Hall's finances. Total income from Commercial Hires, Clubs, Catering and Functions etc. £5562. Net Income £1800. The Statement for the 30 day account showed £10612, including £5.34 interest after tax! There are no creditors – all up to date. The Burns Supper made a profit of £622 – a worthwhile evening. Insurance due for renewal now.

6.. Caretaker's Report.

Routine maintenance carried out. Oil 70% full. 2000 litres delivered. Fluorescent tube replaced. Before Maggies, Errol will organise the Septic Tank to be emptied. 75% of cost will be passed onto Highland Council. Errol also to move the First Aid Box to a lower level for easy access by everyone when the phone is installed.

7. **A.O.C.B**

a)Sign for Ceilidh Board - Phil

Phil said he had contacted three firms for quotations for a new board. Prices for a Plastic board varied between £50- £80.for a 3x3 board, printing included. The Committee all agreed that the existing board should be replaced and £100 available for cost. Clare suggested Phil go ahead and order the Ceilidh Board and for Errol and Phil to put up a secure stand. Errol and Phil to decide on size of board.

b)

Bookers Card - Cherry

It was not difficult to organise a card for the Hall. Only needed to show utility bills and apply on line as a Charity.

c)

Float - lan

lan kept the float from the Burns Supper and suggested Cherry have a small float and top up each time she makes a claim. The offer is there if Cherry wants a float. Cherry said if she needs to do a bigger shop she will then ask lan.

x 4, Small sharp knives, Plastic Covers for tables (big). £10 to £12 per metre. Clare asked the Committee if she should go ahead. All agreed. She also needed Tea Towels x2packs and Display trays which cost around £20. Clare to liaise with Cherry.

Chairs – Clare had a rethink regarding the Hall Chairs. To replace metal with similar padded. It was decided that there should be two complete padded stands and the non padded chairs be kept for situations like Maggies. Clare to get a quote for 72 padded chairs from Alpha Furniture. Cost per chair £31.00 plus v.a.t.
